**BGE Course:** Drama

## **Brief Description of Course:**

This Course allows learners to develop practical skills creating and presenting drama.

Learners will also develop **drama production skills**.

In this Course, learners are encouraged to exercise imagination and creativity. They will develop important skills, attitudes and attributes of the four capacities, including creativity and adaptability, enthusiasm, a willingness to learn and confidence.

This Course encourages learners to be creative and to express themselves in different ways.

Learning through drama helps learners to appreciate cultural values, identities and ideas.

**Course elements include:** Acting Out, Improvisation, Movement, Role Play, Working with Scripts, Voice, Props, Radio, Theatre Lighting, Video, Costume, Make up and Script Writing

This Course also provides scope for personalisation and choice and articulates well with future study at National 4/5.

## **Assessment Strategies:**

All pupils will be assessed on each of the course elements previously listed.

Learners are encouraged to use peer assessment strategies to allow the development of constructive criticism and set achievable targets.

Summative end of unit tests, a drama diary and regular homework also inform progress.

## **Pupil Commitment:**

Learners are expected to attend extra rehearsals and may also have the opportunity to attend theatre excursions and workshops.

Learners must also be able to contribute constructively to group work activities.
