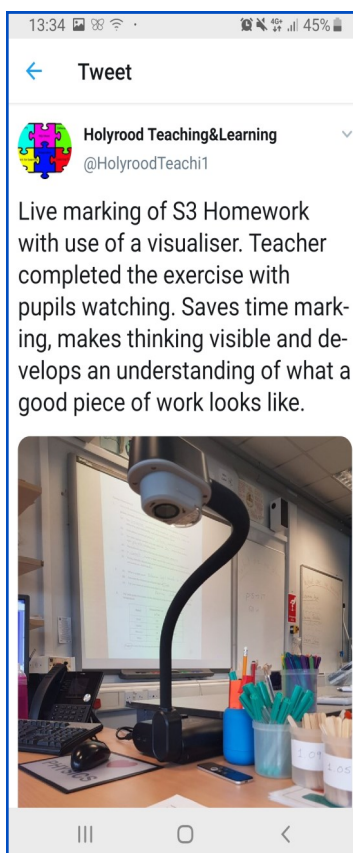
Welcome to our First Edition

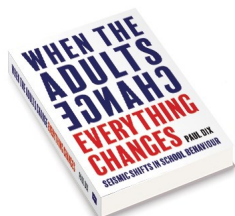

Book of the Month

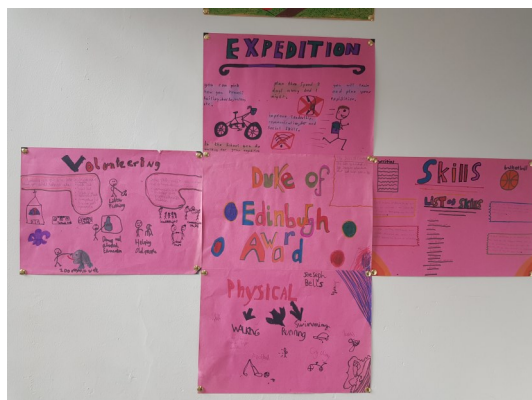
