




S1 Personalisation & Choice Information Evening








Every young person in Scotland is **ENTITLED** to experience a broad general education.

This broad general education builds upon their experiences from Primary Education through to the end of S3

Learning takes place across all of the experiences and outcomes, as far as is consistent with each young person's needs.

Most young people will start on Level 3 in S1 but some will continue to work at Level 2/1. By the end of S3 most young people will have achieved Level 3 and many will have achieved Level 4.


